Don't just ask what happened—ask how?

How did God comfort them?

"...by the coming of Titus"

Don't just ask what happened—ask how?

John 4:1-2: "Jesus was making and <u>baptizing</u> more disciples than John..."

How was Jesus baptizing disciples?

"...(although Jesus Himself was not baptizing, but <u>His disciples</u> were)."

Don't just ask what happened—ask how?

Acts 10:19–20: "the Spirit said to him, 'Behold, three men are looking for you...for I have sent them Myself."

How did the Spirit send those men?

Through an <u>angel</u> ("an angel of God... 'Now dispatch some men to Joppa...'" 10:3-5, 22) and through Cornelius, ("he summoned two of his servants...he sent them to Joppa" 10:7-8).

Take-aways

Always ask the key question: How?

Because of the HS, we can have faith in the words of the Bible (Lk. 12:11-12).

We need to study, teach, and preach God's word (Hebrews 2:1-4).
