


Creation, and People Begin to Sin Genesis 1-11

"So the Lord gave Israel all the land which He had sworn to give to their fathers, and they possessed it and lived in it" (Joshua 21:43).






1 st Deportation	Jeremiah 25:11-12	"these nations will serve the king of Babylon seventy years"	605 BC
