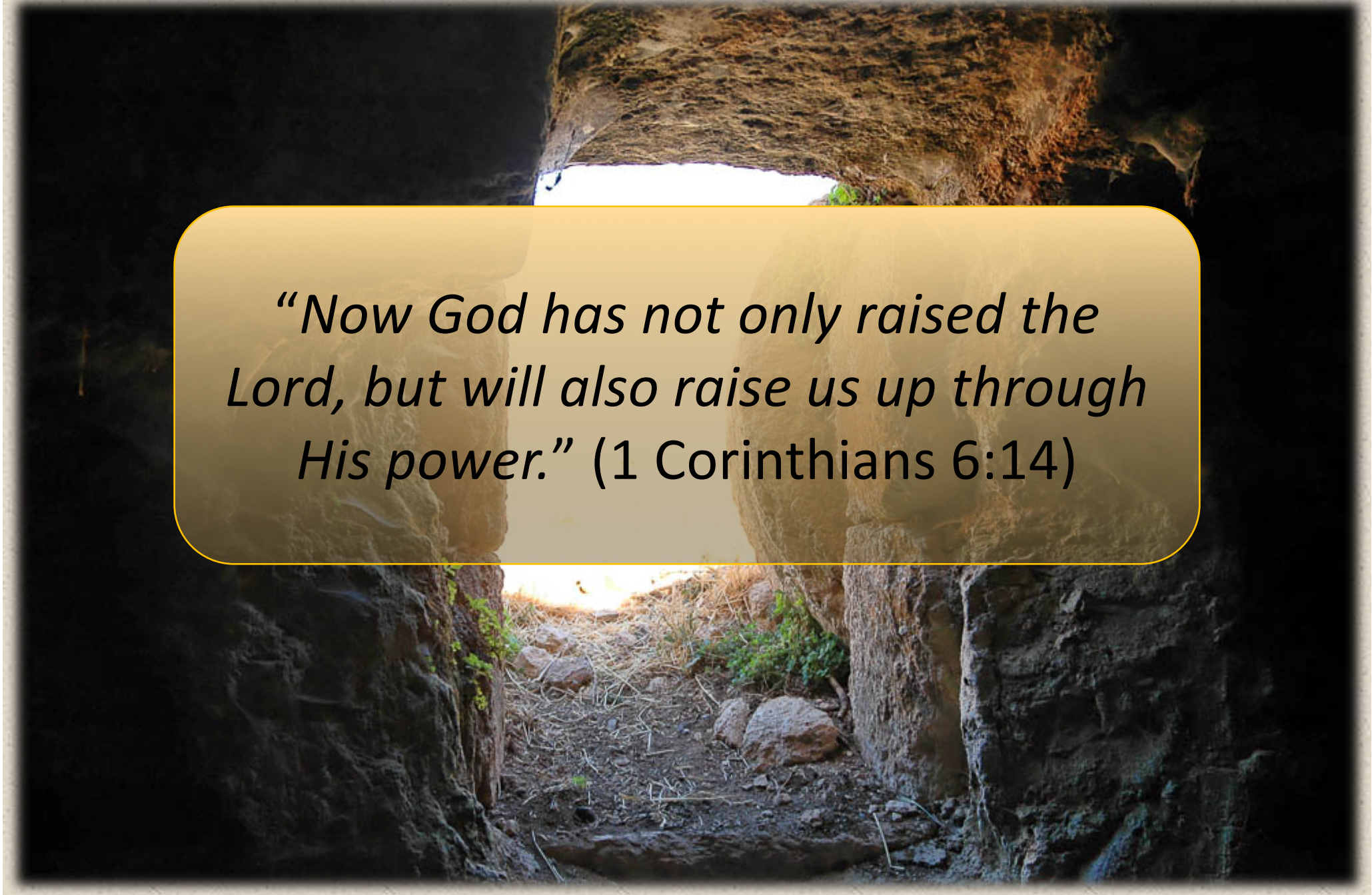


What the resurrection means to me
