

Matthew 5:7 "Blessed Are The Merciful For They Shall Receive Mercy."

Luke 10:25-27

- 25 "And behold, a lawyer stood up to put him to the test, saying, "Teacher, what shall I do to inherit eternal life?"
- **26** He said to him, "What is written in the Law? How do you read it?"
- 27 And he answered, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself." ESV

Luke 10:28-30

- 28 "And he said to him, "You have answered correctly; do this, and you will live."
- 29 But he, desiring to justify himself, said to Jesus, "And who is my neighbor?"
- **30** Jesus replied, "A man was going down from Jerusalem to Jericho, and he fell among robbers, who stripped him and beat him and departed, leaving him half dead." ESV

Luke 10:31-34

- 31 Now by chance a priest was going down that road, and when he saw him he passed by on the other side.
- 32 So likewise a Levite, when he came to the place and saw him, passed by on the other side.
- 33 But a Samaritan, as he journeyed, came to where he was, and when he saw him, he had compassion.
- 34 He went to him and bound up his wounds, pouring on oil and wine...." ESV

- Luke 10:34-37 34 ... Then he set him on his own animal and brought him to an inn and took care of him.
- 35 And the next day he took out two denarii and gave them to the innkeeper, saying, 'Take care of him, and whatever more you spend, I will repay you when I come back.'
- 36 Which of these three, do you think, proved to be a neighbor to the man who fell among the robbers?"
- 37 He said, "The one who showed him mercy." And Jesus said to him, "You go, and do likewise." ESV

Titus 3:5-7

- 5 "he saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to his own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit,
- 6 whom he poured out on us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior,
- 7 so that being justified by his grace we might become heirs according to the hope of eternal life." ESV

Ephesians 2:4-6

- 4 "But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us,
- 5 even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ— by grace you have been saved—
- 6 and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus," ESV

- **Micah 6:6-8** "With what shall I come before the Lord, and bow myself before God on high? Shall I come before him with burnt offerings, with calves a year old?
- 7 Will the Lord be pleased with thousands of rams, with ten thousands of rivers of oil? Shall I give my firstborn for my transgression, the fruit of my body for the sin of my soul?"
- 8 He has told you, O man, what is good; and what does the Lord require of you but to do justice, and to love [mercy] kindness, and to walk humbly with your God?" ESV

Psalm 25:6 "Remember your mercy, O Lord, and your steadfast love, for they have been from of old." ESV

Lamentations 3:22-23

- 22 The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases; his mercies never come to an end;
- 23 they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.

ESV

Nehemiah 9:17

17 "But you are a God ready to forgive, gracious and merciful, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love, and did not forsake them.

James 2:13

13 "For judgment is without mercy to one who has shown no mercy. Mercy triumphs over judgment." ESV

Matthew 18:21-24

- 21 "Then Peter came up and said to him, "Lord, how often will my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? As many as seven times?"
- 22 Jesus said to him, "I do not say to you seven times, but seventy times seven.
- 23 "Therefore the kingdom of heaven may be compared to a king who wished to settle accounts with his servants.
- **24** When he began to settle, one was brought to him who owed him ten thousand talents." ESV

- 25 And since he could not pay, his master ordered him to be sold, with his wife and children and all that he had, and payment to be made.
- 26 So the servant fell on his knees, imploring him, 'Have patience with me, and I will pay you everything.'
- 27 And out of pity for him, the master of that servant released him and forgave him the debt.
- 28 But when that same servant went out, he found one of his fellow servants who owed him a hundred denarii, and seizing him, he began to choke him, saying, 'Pay what you owe.'" ESV

- 29 So his fellow servant fell down and pleaded with him, 'Have patience with me, and I will pay you.'
- 30 He refused and went and put him in prison until he should pay the debt.
- 31 When his fellow servants saw what had taken place, they were greatly distressed, and they went and reported to their master all that had taken place.
- 32 Then his master summoned him and said to him, 'You wicked servant! I forgave you all that debt because you pleaded with me." ESV

Matthew 18:33-35

33 And should not you have had mercy on your fellow servant, as I had mercy on you?'

34 And in anger his master delivered him to the jailers, until he should pay all his debt.

35 So also my heavenly Father will do to every one of you, if you do not forgive your brother from your heart." ESV
