

# How Bible Authority is Revealed to Man



Man can thus:


- ✓ <u>**Read</u>** the Direct revelation God</u>

✓ Be <u>saved</u> eternally





- 2. "Where does it say we can't?"
- 3. "It doesn't say not to"
- 4. "Where the Bible is silent, we are free to choose"
- **5.** "Perhaps we need a new hermeneutic"



# **RESPECTING GOD'S SILENCE**

Silence does not mean consent

Many passages teach that one MUST not act without God's permission

Sohn taught in John 3:4 that "sin is a transgression of law"

Sohn reminds us in 2 John 9 that "Whoever transgresses and does not abide in the doctrine of Christ does not have God"

Jesus said in Matt 7:21 "Not everyone who says to me 'Lord, Lord shall enter the kingdom of heaven but he that <u>does the will of my Father in heaven</u>"

- Thomas Campbell, an early American gospel preacher & restorer, formed a cliché which stated,
  - "We speak where the Bible speaks and are silent where the Bible is silent"
- > This is predicated on 1 Peter 4:11
  - "If anyone speaks, let him speak as the oracles of God"
- If God has not spoken, man should not presume to speak for Him

- **1.** Where there is no clear:
  - Direct Command
  - Approved Apostolic Example
  - Necessary Inference to act

2. Any step in that direction is in violation of God's word

The Bible teaches that we must act at all times by the AUTHORITY OF CHRIST

Anything we do in the name of Christ that is *not* authorized is LAW-LESS-NESS and therefore sinful

Se Careful to <u>Speak Where the Bible Speaks and Be</u> <u>Silent Where the Bible is Silent</u>

Obey what God has said

\* Respect what He has not said

# Three Bible Examples of God's Silence

#### Leviticus 10:1-2

FOLLOWING GOD'S

PATTERN


Nadab and Abihu offered unauthorized fire before God. They weren't told not to do this; they were simply told what they were supposed to do and then did something else.

#### Hebrews 1:5


This is an argument for the superiority of Christ over the angels based on something God DID NOT SAY.


#### Hebrews 7:11-14

Moses did not teach that those from Judah could not be priests; but he told what tribe the priests should come from and silence eliminated all others, even the one Christ was from.



Perhaps a couple of illustrations from everyday life and a couple from the Bible will help us to understand that <u>silence is</u> <u>not permission</u>






# Lesson 3 - The Silence of the Scriptures Basic Illustrations

- A search warrant could it be argued that a judge had not said one was necessary?
- Mail Order Catalog if your order was exceeded could you rightly argue that your did not tell them not to?
- Acts 15:23-24 "You must be circumcised and keep the law . . . We gave no such commandment"


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- Lord's Supper Elements the Bible teaches that unleavened bread and the fruit of the vine are to be used. God did not have to say other items could not be used.



Some examples of things that the Bible is silent about and therefore, we have no authority to get involved with them:

- Church Sponsored <u>Recreation</u>
- <u>Sponsoring</u> Church Arrangement
- Human Institutions Doing the Work of the Church




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### The work of the local church is threefold & only three-fold

- 1. Evangelism to preach and teach
- 2. Edification to edify its members; strengthen, build up
- **3.** *Benevolence* limited to saints



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In Evangelism – the support of Missionary Societies

In Edification – the support of "Christian Colleges"

<u>In Benevolence</u> – the support of Orphan's Homes

# **Other Examples of God's Silence Include:**

- Instrumental music in worship
- Infant baptism

FOLLOWING GOD'S

PATTERN

- Voting on church membership
- Clergy/laity distinction
- Special holy days observance
- 1. Not one of these commonly practiced activities is found anywhere in God's word.
- 2. They are not specifically condemned anywhere in the Bible.
- 3. They would only be approved by God if He had included them in His inspired revelation.
- 4. Therefore, they are all wrong, no matter how widely they are practiced.
