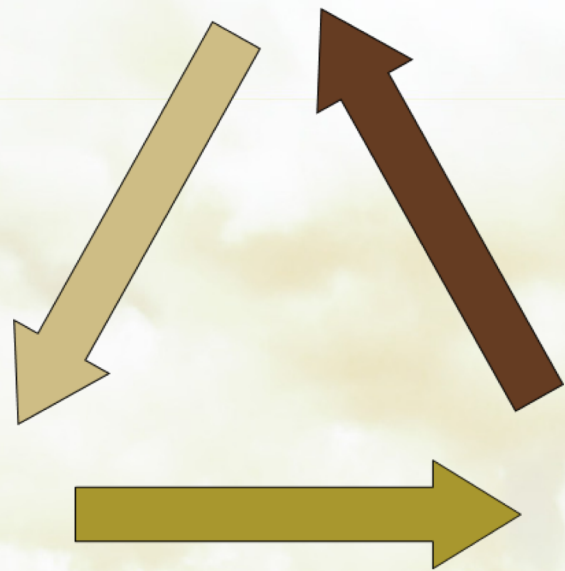

(Matt. 28:19-20)

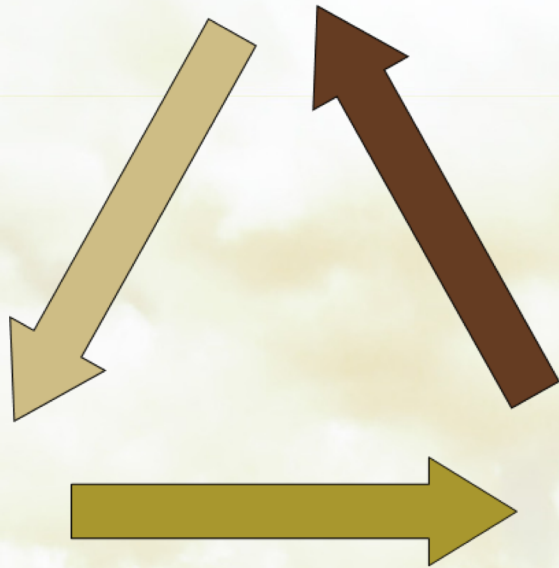

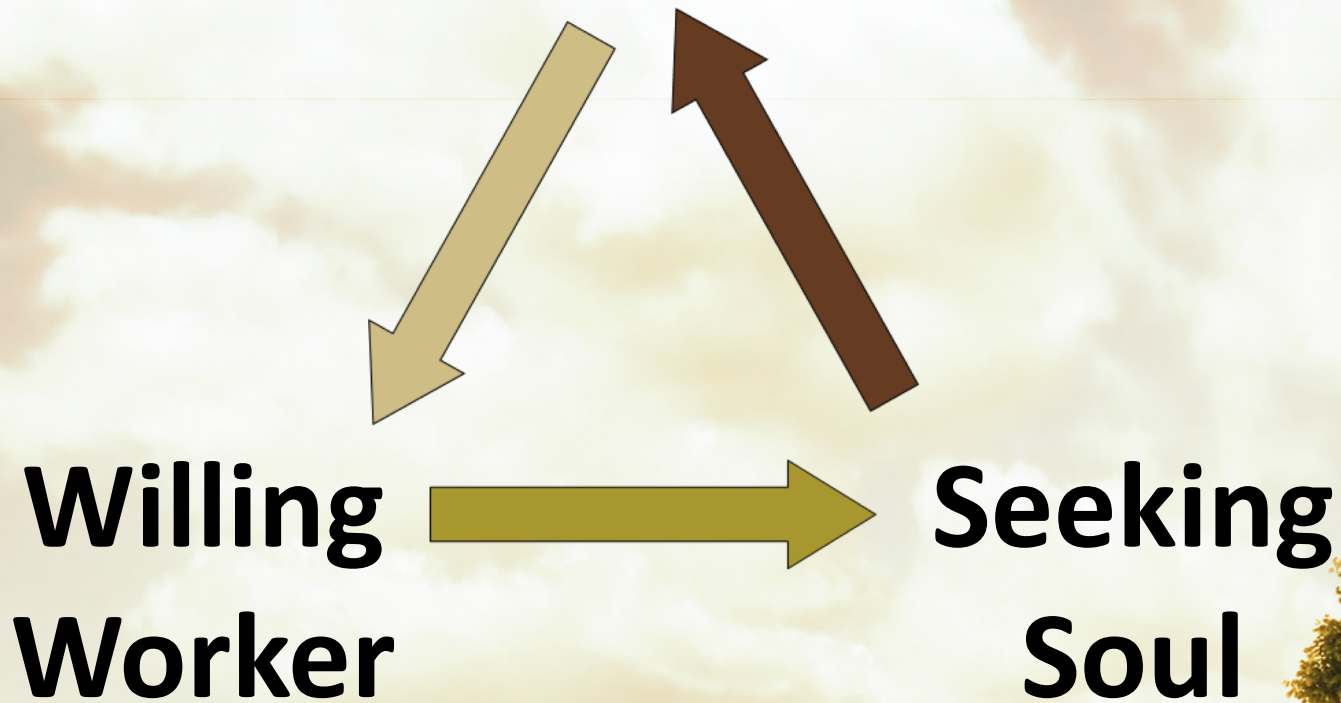

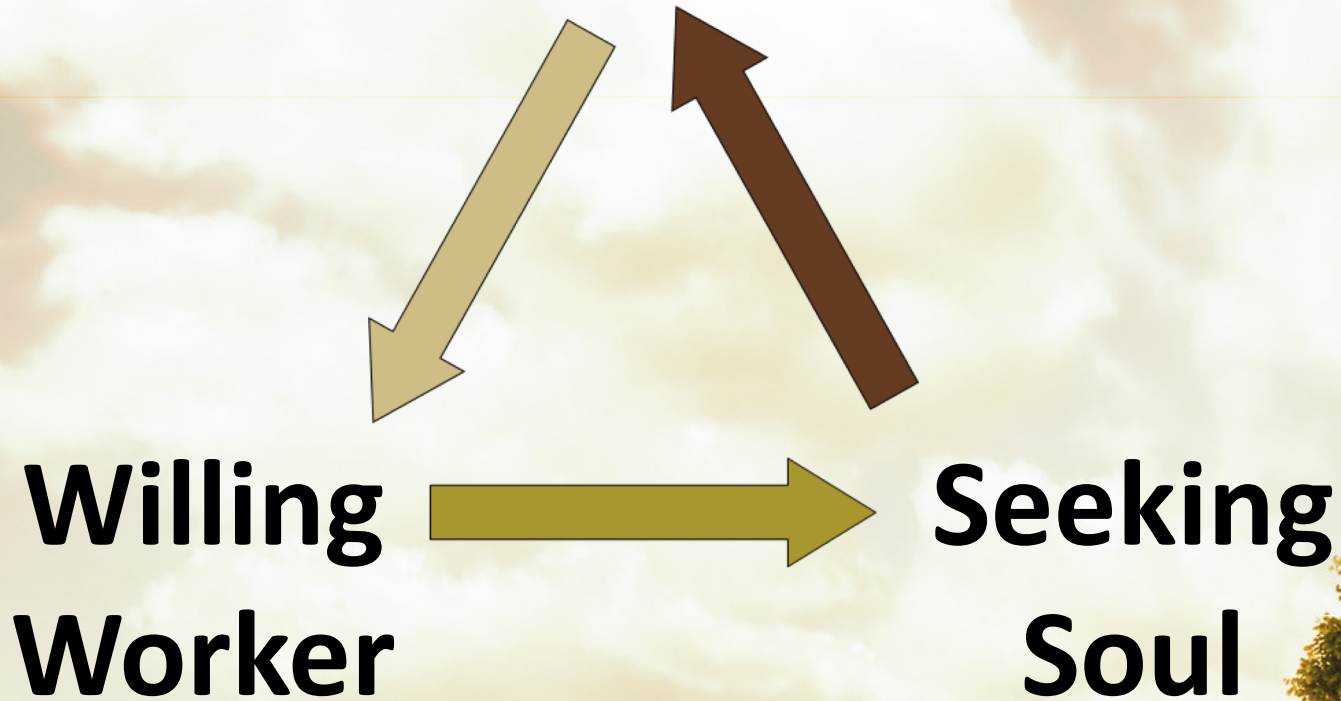

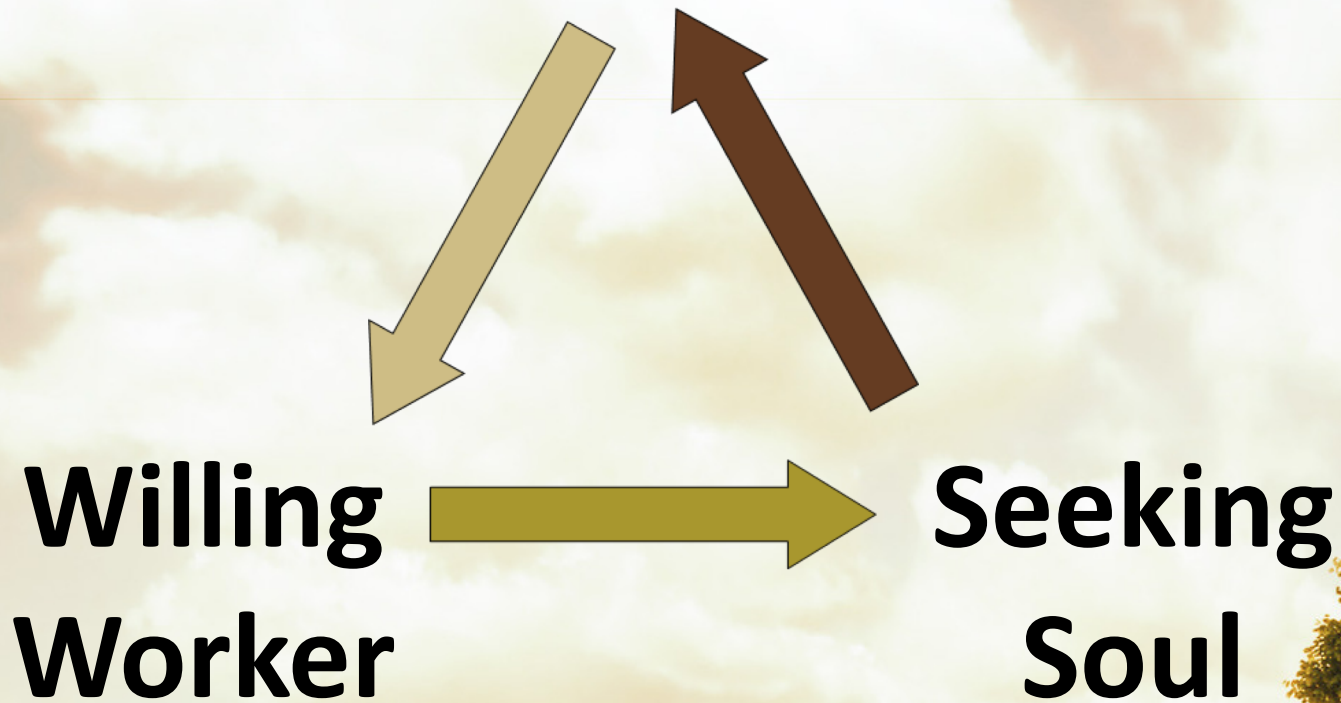
